SUBJECT: Environmental Commitment Statement

1. The 200th RED HORSE Squadron (200 RHS) is committed to excellence in environmental stewardship in all our activities at home and abroad. We commit to completing activities in the safest and most environmentally responsible way, as we achieve our vision, and accomplish our mission:

 - o Documentation: keeping adequate user records and maintaining the AFRIMS drive and VEMO website for single source environmental document repositories.
